



HACIENDA LA COMPAÑÍA DE JESÚS

The name of this hacienda is "THE COMPANY OF JESUS" since it belonged to the order of the Jesuits, who were established in Ecuador 300 years ago until, in 1767, the King of Spain Carlos III expelled them from Spain and their colonies.

This has remained in the hands of the Jarrin family for more than 5 generations, it is still a family home, and for 15 years we offer different services and activities for tourists.

LOCATION

La Compañía hacienda is located 5km from the city of Cayambe in a northerly direction; the entrance is on the Panamericana next to the ROSADEx rose plantation.

THE HACIENDA

This French-Neoclassical house was built in 1919 and still retains its ceilings, wallpaper and flats in perfect condition. It is decorated with the original furniture of the time and maintains a permanent display of roses that are produced on our plantation.

In addition, you can visit the original Chapel that dates from the early seventeenth century and was built by parents Jesuits.

The sculptures that are on the altar belong to the prestigious "Escuela Quiteña de Artes".



SERVICES & FACILITIES

- Showroom of roses in El Troje: El Troje was used by the Jesuits as a barn, now it has become the only museum of roses in Ecuador, where there are exhibited more than 5,000 stems of the most colorful varieties of the farm.
- Plantation of roses "Rosadex": Part of the tour of the Hacienda, includes a visit to the rose plantation where the process to produce export roses will be explained with the visit to a greenhouse and to the postharvest.
- Breakfast with buffet service.
- Lunch with several options of Ecuadorian dishes and vegetarian options.
- Tea buffet service
