

NAPO WILDLIFE CENTER

Going out of city life to the eco-community of the jungle and its inhabitants is a fascinating experience. Napo Wildlife Center is a place different from the others that is in the heart of one of the ecosystems with greater biodiversity in the planet. Ecuador's Yasuní National Park is rich in extraordinary wildlife and vibrant local culture and encompasses nearly 2.5 million hectares of Amazon rainforest. This is truly a jewel that should be appreciated, and the Napo Wildlife Center is the only lodge on the edge of the Yasuní National Park.

LOCATION

The Napo Wildlife Center is located on the northern border of the Yasuní National Park, on the banks of the Napo River. The lodge is reached after a trip in a comfortable boat for 2.5 hours from the city of Coca by the Napo River. At one point, passengers are transferred to paddling in canoes to reduce environmental impacts and preserve the forest and its fauna, in a narrow black river of broken water. This route will take you to Lake Añangu and finally to the red cabins of Napo Wildlife Center.



ACCOMMODATION

Napo Wildlife Center has sixteen luxury cabins. The spacious rooms are comfortable and impeccable, and its services include:

- Two double beds
- A safe-deposit box
- Private bathroom with hot water
- A private balcony with views of the lake and the surrounding area.
- Mosquito nets and closed windows.
- Ceiling fans.
