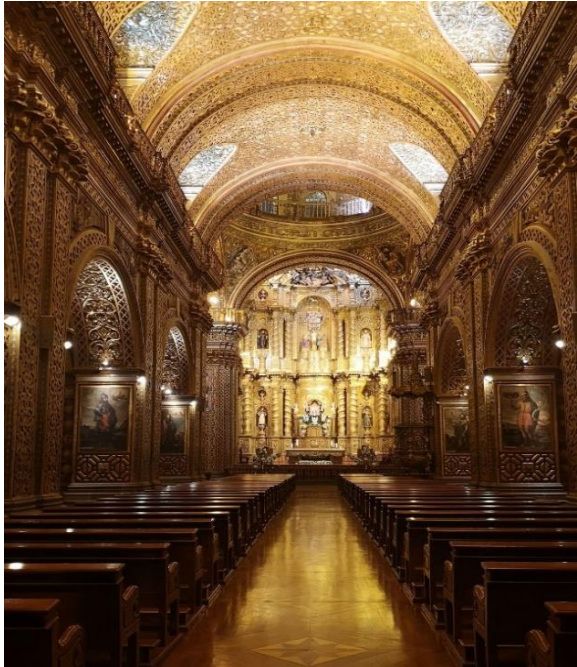


QUITO HISTORIC CENTER AND EQUATOR



In 1978, Quito was declared a UNESCO World Heritage for its distinctive architecture, culture, and history. This private visit will take you to the main highlights in the Old Town and the Middle of the World complex. Our certified guide will pick you up and give a brief overview of modern Quito and the Historic Center.

The visit will start at Plaza de San Francisco, the main temple, choir, museum, and the convent. The tour will continue with a short walk to the La Compañía de Jesús Church, a true masterpiece of baroque architecture and art in Latin America, and then proceed to the city's main square (Plaza Grande), the historical, political, and religious heart of Quito.

The country's name is the result of the visit of the Geodesic Mission in the 18th century. This mission came to Quito to measure the latitude and define the shape of the earth. They established that the planet was round and that the " equator" was in this country. The Middle of the World complex has several museums, shops, and a trapezoidal monument that offers an observation platform for amazing views of the Andes mountains. The monument has a 100- foot- long yellow line on the ground that is the city's most famous photo-op with one foot in each hemisphere.
